## What Time Is Breakfast? How Early Can I Come to School? Where Is The Correct Door?

**Latch Key (before school care)** begins at  
6:30am. Please park in the small north  
parking lot. You must walk your student into  
the building (cafeteria door) and sign them in.  
**Breakfast** is served from 7:35am - 7:50 am  
daily in the cafeteria. Please enter through the  
front door on West Street.

**Preschool Door-Main parking lot.** Opens at  
7:40am. Enter on McKibben, park and walk  
student(s) into building. This area is for  
PRESCHOOLERS only unless there are older  
children in the family and they may be  
dropped off as well.

**Drop Off Line Gate** (enter off of McDonel St.)  
is open at 7:40; closes at 7:55 sharp.

**All doors are locked at 7:55am sharp**  
Students arriving after 7:55am must enter the  
front entrance on West Street to enter the  
building and receive their tardy slip.

If you have questions on where to drop off/  
pick up, please ask your teacher or call the  
school office.

Dear Parents, Guardians and Students:

It has been a wonderful start to the new school year, it is nice to have all the smiling faces back at school learning and having fun! We are still collecting paperwork from families, if yours is not turned in please complete it and return tomorrow. The signature page is vital for students to begin using technology, which has already begun, so if we don't have it your student is not able to participate.

We have many new families with us this year, so drop off and pick up will take a little longer. This is a great problem to have! If you are lining up in the car line, please do not block the intersection of McDonel and McKibben St. I recommend you arrive in the afternoon line at 3pm, or no later than 3:05. This will allow families to begin proceeding through the line. We will be watching the flow of traffic to determine if there is an easier way for this to work. Additionally, in the morning, students are not permitted to get out of the car before reaching the cafeteria door for safety reasons.

If you are picking up in a car, do not park on the street and walk in the front door as this is where our bus students assemble and buses park. Also, this is the preschool hallway with students walking to the preschool door for pickup. Car pickups in the front add to the business of dismissal.

All of our preschool families will be parking between the church and the school and walking their child to the door. Parents must walk their children to the door in order to ensure their safety in the parking lot. We don't want any accidents to happen.

Reminder, breakfast is being served in the morning starting at 7:35. Students will come in through the front door when arriving that early for breakfast. If you have any questions about procedures please call the school office.
