Back to School Parent Night: Tuesday, August 16, 2022 * 5pm

Parents will meet in the cafeteria with Mrs. Judy to review general rules and guidelines. Parents will then go to your child's classroom where the teacher will discuss and pass out paperwork on classroom procedures and curriculum. Students will get a sweet treat and a raffle ticket for door prizes during your classroom visit. Those families which have multiple students should attend the 5pm session to allow time to visit *all* your students' classrooms.

We strongly suggest that parents visit the parish hall where community agencies, school groups, parish business office and vendors will be available to discuss programs, tuition arrangements and opportunities. First Day of School (Grades K-8): Thursday, August 18, 2022

Students are permitted to wear school uniform shorts during the months of September and October. Gently used uniforms are available in the school beginning August 8, 2022.

WARD APPAREL, 3619 Elida Rd., is our uniform provider. They have uniform requirements for all grades. Highlights: Preschoolers do not wear uniforms but must be dressed appropriately for learning. Flip flops and shoes without backs (straps) are not suggested as this may cause injury when running or jumping. Fifth (5th) - eighth (8th) grade boys must wear white, button down Oxford shirts (long or short sleeve ONLY) with an embroidered logo and a tie. Fifth (5th) - eighth (8th) grade girls are permitted to wear white, button down Oxford shirts (long or short sleeve) with embroidered logo or Peter Pan collard shirts with logo ONLY. *Students in grades 5-8 are NOT permitted to wear polo style shirts*.

Shot Requirements - 7th Grade

Students entering 7th grade are REQUIRED to have a Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) and a MVCA4 (Meningococcal) vaccine for entrance into school. Students without proof of vaccination will be subject to exclusion from school

The following is a list recommended vaccines available at the health department for teens: Pertussis (Whooping Cough)

HPV (Human Papillomavirus - three doses in a series) Chicken Pox (Varicella - two doses in a series)

Hepatitis A (Hepatitis A -two doses in a series)

Bussing Information

Any student needing to access bussing from **LIMA CITY SCHOOLS** must register for the bus. Families must have the following: 1) a signed, dated letter requesting transportation. 2) A completed LCS Transportation Request Form. 3) A current utility bill (within the last 3 months) showing the mailing and service address. Packets with this information were sent home the last week of school. Additional copies are available in the school office.
