First Day Bell Ringing

Dear Parents, Guardians, Staff and Students:

Welcome back to school, we will soon have our first week under our belts. The faculty and staff are very excited to see all our students' smiling faces everyday. We are blessed to have many new students joining us, along with our old ones. Seeing our school family grow is a joy! Starting the school year requires parents to complete a lot of paperwork, which this year has moved to FinalForms an online program.. This paperwork tells us about your child (medical forms), gives permissions (use of technology) and helps us know more about them. If you haven't completed FinalForms yet, please do so no later than Friday, August 22. Also, all EdChoice paperwork should be turned in by now; again if you have something outstanding we must have this by Friday, August 22.

It is important to us that you receive all the messages and information that you need about what is happening at school. Ensure you have signed up on ClassDojo with your child's classroom teacher, the Remind app and "liked" our facebook page as this is how we communicate with parents.

Drop off and pick up: parents it is vital that you follow the schools' procedures for both drop off and pick up. The process is designed to help things move smoothly as well as keep everyone safe. All K-8 should be dropped off or picked up through the line off of McDonel Street (directions for this are in the school handbook). This starts at 7:40am, with dismissal at 3pm. Our early release day is Wednesday at 2pm. If you are dropping off 7:35-7:40 for breakfast only, you will enter the preschool parking lot off of McKibben St. and your child should enter through the front door. If your child is not eating breakfast they are to be dropped off in the car line on the north side of the building. No one should be entering the parking lot off of West St. as that is how cars leave the parking lot. Most importantly, **no one should be parking in front of the school** to walk their child in or drop them off at the curb. This is the bus lane.

Preschool families should be parking in the parking lot between the church and the school, then walking their child to the door where the preschool teachers will greet them. If there are older children, they will enter through this door as well. At the end of the day, meet the teachers at this same door for pick up. No students without preschool children may enter through the preschool door.

Car riders please do not park across the street from the school on West St. and walk in to pick your child up. Buses use the front door for pick up, so when parents are walking in, this causes congestion and students getting lost, as well as being a safety hazard. If you have questions or concerns please call the school office.

If you have any questions about this, or need clarification please call the school office so we can help keep your child safe. Have a wonderful weekend everyone.
