We have an exciting and busy week ahead as we move into October! Tomorrow, following our All School Mass and Rosary, we will hold our second House System meeting.

At Back to School Night, I shared details about this new program, which is designed to strengthen leadership and community within our school. The House System gives students an opportunity to grow in virtue while fostering connections across grade levels.

Each House has its own virtue, saint, logo, and color. All students, from preschool through 8th grade are part of a House. The Lower Houses include preschool through 4th grade while the Upper Houses are 5th-8th grade. Each House is guided by a teacher "House Guardian" with an Assistant Guardian. Students can earn "points for their House when they are "caught" doing something kind, helpful or virtuous.

At our first House meeting in September, students were "sorted" into their Houses and met their Guardians. Tomorrow, they will receive their House shirts, which must be worn with uniform pants on the first Friday of every month for our monthly House meetings.
