Dear Parents, Guardians, and Families,

Tomorrow, students will bring home their 1st quarter report cards. Before conferences next week, I encourage you to review the report card with your child. Talk together about what they are doing well and where they can continue to grow.

During conferences, your child will share what they are most proud of this quarter and the goals they've set for improvement. You'll also have the opportunity to review your child's assessment information. If you have not yet scheduled your conference, please do so as soon as possible or contact your child's teacher for assistance.

Supporting Your Child at Home

The best way to help your child succeed starts with the basics:

- Sleep and Nutrition: Ensure your child gets enough rest and eats a healthy breakfast each day.
 This helps them arrive ready to learn.
- Limit Screen Time: Especially before bed. Too much screen time can overstimulate the brain and make it harder for children (and adults) to sleep well.

Homework and Reading

Spend time each night reviewing homework and reading with your child. Each grade builds on the previous year's learning, so consistent practice matters.

- If your child struggles, have them bring home their book and classnotes. Re-read lessons, review vocabulary, and ask them to explain what they learned in their own words.
- For our younger students, focus on letters, letter sounds and sight words to build a strong reading foundation.

Attendance Matters

Daily, on-time attendance plays a major role in academic success. When reviewing your child's report card, please look at the number of *days or hours missed*. Frequent absences often lead to learning gaps.

- The final bell in the morning rings at 7:55 a.m.
- Instruction and small-group tutoring begins by 8:00 a.m.
- We recommend arriving by 7:40 a.m. so students can unpack and prepare for the day.

Each school day equals about **6.5 hours of learning**. Missing more than **10% of a school year (114 hours)** is considered excessive and will affect academic progress. If your child has already missed 38 hours (6 days) or more of school this is a concern and needs to be addressed. While tardies are not in the total count of hours missed on the report card, they still count in the total hours missed, and these late arrivals impact your child's learning time.

Our Shared Responsibility

As a Catholic school, our faith teaches us that parents are the primary educator of their children. We are partners in this important mission.

We have your child for about 13% of the year (1142 hours)-the rest of their time is spent with you. That means your partnership and support at home are essential. Together, we can make sure each child grows in faith and knowledge.
