Celebrate the month of the Rosary with us as we create an interactive living Rosary


When: Fri. Oct. 17th at 9 a.m.



Dear Parents, Guardians, and Families,

Parent-Teacher Conferences are just around the corner, and this year we are excited to introduce an important new approach, Student-Led Conferences.

Instead of the traditional parent-teacher format, your child will take the lead in sharing their learning journey. During the conference, your child will reflect on their progress, showcase their work, and receive feedback from you and the teacher. You, your child, your child's teacher, and any other adult your child or teacher would like to invite, will participate together. Each conference will last 20 minutes.

Over the past few years, our teachers and staff have researched and trained extensively to implement Student-Led Conferences. We believe this model helps students take ownership of their learning, fosters meaningful reflection, and strengthens communication between school and families.

If you feel a private conference with a teacher is needed, you may still schedule one for a later date. We truly value your partnership and know that your involvement is key to your child's success.

- **Wednesday, October 29**

Please use the link below to schedule your conference, we are counting on 100% participation as we launch this new format!

When you enter the web address into your browser window, you will see a list of classroom teachers. Click on your child's teacher and select an available time slot. Repeat this for each of your children. If you do not have internet access, please send a note to your child's teacher with your preferred times.

You will schedule one conference time for your child. All homeroom teachers will be present for that meeting. A separate letter will be sent home with details about your child's remote learning day which is on Wednesday, October 29.
