### 2nd Week of Advent

The Candle of PEACE

The Peace Candle, lit during the second week of Advent, symbolizes the peace Jesus brings to the world, representing the fulfillment of prophecy (Isaiah 9:6) and the angels' announcement of "peace on earth" (Luke 2:14). The PEACE candle, also called the "Bethlehem Candle," marks Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem, reminding us that true peace comes through preparing our hearts to receive Christ and confronting internal disorder, rather than waiting for perfect external conditions.
