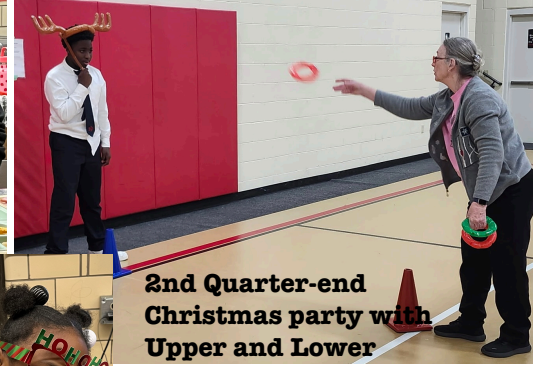

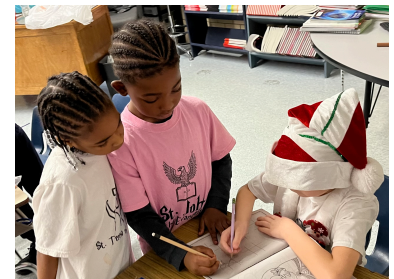
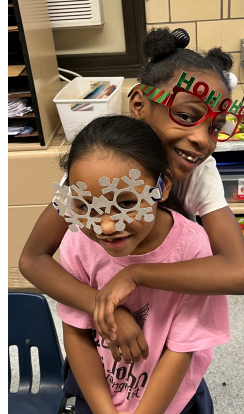

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Families,

Welcome back and Happy New Year! It has been wonderful to welcome our students back to school and see so many smiling faces this week. I hope your family enjoyed a restful break filled with special time together.

As we return to our routines, it is time to reset and refocus on academics. Monday marked the start of the **3rd quarter**, and as we all know, the remainder of the school year moves very quickly. Report cards will be sent home with students tomorrow. Please take time to review them with your child. If you have any questions or concerns, do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher. This is also a great opportunity to set goals together for a strong and successful second semester. We are also beginning our **mid-year MAP testing and assessments**, which help us measure student progress since fall.

While reviewing report cards this week, I paid close attention to **attendance**. Regular attendance is essential for student success. Being on time is just as important, as tardiness can disrupt both your child's learning and the classroom environment. Please note that both excused and unexcused absences count toward absenteeism. Missing just one day per month is considered chronic absenteeism, and can negatively impact learning. If your child has accumulated **5 or more absences (32 hours)**, I encourage you to create a plan to ensure that they are present each school day. Every minute matters, and consistent attendance is closely linked to stronger reading and math achievement.

This week we also observed the **Feast of the Epiphany**, traditionally celebrated on January 6. During our House Meeting we shared an Epiphany Blessing at school. Using blessed chalk, we marked our entrance doors with the inscription **20+C+M+B+26**, symbolizing both the year and the names of the three wise men—Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. The letters also stand for the Latin phrase *Christus mansionem benedicat*, meaning "May Christ bless this home." This beautiful tradition invites Jesus into our school, and asks for His protection and guidance as we continue the Christmas season, which concludes this Saturday.

Thank you for your continued partnership and support. We look forward to a focused and productive semester ahead.
