Financial Obligations

Re-Registration for 2026-27

Registration through FinalForms and EdChoice paperwork is currently underway. Due to strong enrollment, many classrooms are already full. To secure your child's placement for next year, please complete re-registration by April 30. After this date, we cannot guarantee that your child's spot will be held, as we are actively receiving new enrollment inquiries and maintaining waitlists in several grade levels.

End-of-Year Assessments

Throughout April, teachers will be administering the end of year assessments. It is essential that students arrive at school each day on time, well rested, and having eaten a healthy breakfast. These habits support both daily learning and assessment success.

With many activities taking place-including field trips, registration tasks, and sports sign-ups-please be sure to regularly check your child's backpack, Class Dojo and email for the most up to date information.
