Dear Parents, Guardians, and Families,

Tomorrow marks the midterm of the first quarter. Over the past four weeks, I have been blessed to witness so many positive things in our school - students learning with enthusiasm, friendships blossoming, acts of kindness, and meaningful conversations among our staff, students and families. Together, we are working to form the next generation, a task that is both a privilege and a challenge in today's culture, where too often violence is used to silence differing voices.

This year, we have already been reminded of the fragility of life: in June and again in September, public figures who dedicated themselves to creating a better world for our children lost their lives. School shootings have taken both students and staff. On September 11, we commemorated the tragic loss of life in our own country at the hands of extremists. And each day, a quick scroll through social media shows how easily words can be turned into weapons, whether behind the shield of anonymity or out in the open. My heart grows heavy when I think of these things, especially knowing the children in our care will one day be the leaders of tomorrow.

Yet, I find hope in our mission here at St. Rose Catholic School. With you, our parents and partners, we are striving to raise not just leaders but future saints. We call our students to kindness, to Christ-like behavior, to resolve conflict with compassion and dialogue. We also hold them accountable when mistakes are made, guiding them to learn and grow. Thank you for trusting us with this sacred task- teaching your children not to respond with violence, but with words; not to divide, but to seek unity, even when we disagree.

This month, the Church celebrated the canonization of its first millennial saint, St. Carlo Acutis, known as "God's influencer" for the way he used technology to spread the faith. His example inspires us to help our students-your children-become influencers of goodness, love, and truth in a world that so deeply needs them.
