Ash Wednesday marks the start of the 40-day Lenten season, calling Catholics to repentance, fasting, and prayer in preparation for Easter. Ashes, blessed and applied to the forehead, symbolize mortality ("dust to dust"), humility, and a desire to turn away from sin. It is a day of fast and abstinence.

Symbolism of Ashes: The ashes are made from burning the palms from the previous year's Palm Sunday. They represent penance, the fragility of human life, and the need for God's mercy. **Fasting and Abstinence:** Ash Wednesday is a mandatory day of fasting (one full meal, two smaller meals for those aged 18-59) and abstinence from meat (for those 14 and older).

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Families,

This week, we began the season of Lent with our Ash Wednesday Mass. It was a beautiful and prayerful way to start this sacred time in the Liturgical Calendar. For the second time this school year, our teachers and staff served and read at mass. While we usually rotate these roles among grade levels, we felt it was important for our students to see the adults in their school lives actively participating and taking on these roles.

Our students were well prepared by their teachers and understood the meaning of receiving ashes. They approached the altar with reverence and respect. Parishioners commented after mass on how prayerful and attentive students were, which was a wonderful affirmation of their faith.

As we begin this Lenten journey we warmly invite you to join us on Thursday's at 11:15 for Stations of the Cross. This devotion takes approximately 20 minutes and is a meaningful way to reflect on Christ's sacrifice. This week, our 7th grade students led the school in prayer, and did an outstanding job.

We look forward to walking this Lenten season together as a faith community. Have a wonderful week everyone!
